Sealed bids in sets of seven, (one (1) original and six (6) copies) will be received in the office of the County Purchasing Agent, until 2:00 PM on 03/08/2012 and opened immediately in that office in the presence of the County Auditor and the Purchasing Agent. Bidders are specifically advised that any bid delivered after this time will be returned unopened.

Submitted bids will be publicly opened on **03/08/2012 at 2:00 PM** in the Purchasing Agent's office located in the Galveston County Courthouse, 722 Moody Avenue (21st St), Fifth (5th) Floor, Galveston, Texas 77550.

A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit shall be required for each set of plans and specifications. Bids will be completed on the forms and proposal sheets provided.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Certified or Cashier's Check or acceptable Bidder's Bond in the amount of 5% of bid as a guarantee that, if awarded the contract, within sixty (60) days from the date of bid opening, the bidder will enter into a contract and execute Performance and Payment Bonds statutorily required for public works projects. The county intends to award a contract within 60 days.
