OPEN RECORDS COMPLAINT CHECKLIST

- 1. <u>Contact the Office of the Attorney General</u> Open Government Hotline at (877-673-6839). This is a toll free number and they will attempt to resolve your complaint. You may go to their website for additional assistance at www.oag.state.tx.us.
- 2. If the Attorney General's Office is unable to resolve your complaint and you wish to have this office open a criminal complaint, please provide this office with all of the necessary documentation.
- 3. Texas Law provides a criminal penalty for:

An officer for public information, or the officer's agent, commits an offense if, with criminal negligence, the officer or the officer's agent *fails or refuses* to give access to, or to permit or provide copying of, public information to a requestor as provided by this chapter. (See Section 552.353(a) of the Government Code).

- 4. It is a **defense to the prosecution** that the governmental body did a timely request for a decision to the Attorney General's Office under section 552.301 of the Government Code.
- 5. If the governmental body does not request an attorney general decision timely, the **presumption** is that the information is public (see section 552.302 of the Government Code).

- 6. The **Attorney General's Office or a requestor may compel** a governmental body to make information available if they refuse to do so without a legal exception. This would require a civil law suit to be filed.
- 7. If you have:
 - A) Made a written request to a governmental body that was clear and not over-broad, and
 - B) Allowed the governmental body a **reasonable amount of time** to produce the information, but not delay, and
 - C) **Allowed for the Attorney General** to provide the governmental body with a decision if timely requested, and
 - D) Contacted the Attorney General's Office and have been told that there is no exception to disclosure, and
 - E) Provide our office with:
 - A completed "checklist for criminal complaint" with all relevant information, and
 - 2) A **copy of your dated written request** to the governmental body, and
 - 3) A copy of any and all communications with the Attorney General's Office, and

- 4) A copy of any and all responses or opinions received from the governmental body, and
- 5) **Proof** that the requested information exists and is retrievable, and
- 6) Who you believe is failing to provide the information.
- 7) This office will then review the merits of your complaint and respond to you in a timely manner.
