ORDER LIFTING STAY

The Court entered an order on October 26, 2009 staying all discovery in all Hurricane Ike residential and commercial cases involving Texas Windstorm Insurance Association. The parties have agreed to the lifting of this stay.

Thus, the Court orders as follows: The November 9, 2009 Order provides that all institutional discovery may only be sent by the Plaintiffs' Steering Committee. The Stay is lifted as to any institutional discovery propounded by the Plaintiffs Steering Committee. TWIA need not respond to any institutional discovery propounded by any individual plaintiff.

The Stay is also lifted as to case-specific discovery. Any case-specific written discovery served during the course of the stay or which came due during the stay will be due on the later of February 8, 2010 or on the date provided by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure if the original due date is later than February 8, 2010.

This Order does not lift the Stay in the original Standing Order, only the Stay entered by the October 26 Order.
