- 9. Where is your firm and the resources used for this project located?
- 10. Is your firm and all employees who will provide these services CJIS compliant?
- 11. Have or will the appropriate background checks be performed for resources assigned to this project, before the commencement of this project, to meet CJIS requirements?
- 12. Provide a minimum of three references.
