The following information is being provided to aid in the preparation of your RFP submittal(s):

Bid Proposal Sheet:

Please find attached an amended Bid Proposal Sheet. All respondents are to disregard the Bid Proposal Sheet that was included in the original bid packet. The attached Bid Proposal Sheet must be completed and returned with submittals seeking consideration for award.

Questions:

Question #1:

Do we do both decks simultaneously or start with one, then move to the other?

Response:

Galveston County would prefer to have one deck remain open to the public during construction. The recommended sequence is to start with the larger South deck first, then move to the smaller

North deck.

Question #2:

Will you be clearing the shrubs/trees around the decking prior to construction starting?

Response:

An add alternate line item for clearing the vegetation has been added to the bid form. If the price is acceptable, the contractor will be authorized perform the vegetation removal. If it's too high, then

Galveston County will do it.

Question #3:

Can we utilize and block off the parking lot when construction starts?

Response:

Yes, parking spaces may be blocked with limitations, but the roadway needs to remain open at all times. There should always be 8-10 parking spots open nearest the boat ramp, which will remain open and accessible to the public during construction.

Question #4:

What if we need to close the boat ramp?

Response:

This is not expected to be required. If it is needed, the Commissioners' Court has to approve it and a 30-day notice has to be issued for public awareness.

Question #5:

Will there be certified payroll?

Response:

Yes, this is a FEMA project and will require certified payroll.

Question #6:

Do we need to replace the signage?

Response:

No, that is not part of the project.

Question #7:

Do we need to save the sign posts?

Response:

Yes, the signposts need to be when removed and the contractor should notify the Parks and Cultural Services Department personnel of their location. They will store them until the project is

completed.

Ouestion #8:

What is the deadline for questions?

Response:

Monday, April 10, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

Ouestion #9:

When does the bid open?

Response:

Friday, April 21, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.

Question 10:

Will this still be a navigable waterway during the duration of this project? If so, will

longshoremen be required?

Response:

Where the lower part of Clear Creek becomes Clear Lake, the waterway is navigable. The upper portion of Clear Creek near the site is only used for recreational purposes. No longshoremen will

be required.

Ouestion #11:

It was mentioned at the pre-bid meeting on site that we would need to include dewatering. Can

you please clarify this?

Response:

Clear Creek is subject to the daily tide. At high tide, there will be water underneath portions of the decks. Dewatering is not a specific plan requirement, but should be evaluated for worker safety.

Do the 8x8 posts underneath the North Deck connection to the sidewalk need to be replaced?

Response:

Question #12:

The 8x8 posts are connected to a concrete foundation with a galvanized post base and anchor bolt. After the deck is removed, the posts will be individually evaluated. Some of them were vertically aligned and had no visible damage, so those can remain. There were two (2) underneath the deck, which were both tilting significantly, that need to be replaced including the anchor bolts. The

concrete foundation should be acceptable for reuse.
