To All Prospective Proposers:

The following information is being provided to aid in the preparation of your RFP submittal(s):

Question #1: Building floorplans and locations of drops

Response:

There are no floor plans available for these locations. All are low ceilings. Response must assume

less than 150 ft run for a flat rate per drop.

Question #2:

Dropped or hard (drywall) ceilings? Everywhere?

Response:

Dropped ceilings and drywall.

Question #3:

Do you need WAPs installed?

• if so, quantities don't match (47 WAPs v.s. 22 Drops)

Response:

47 represent the total amount of WAP's that will be mounted. Some WAP's will replace existing.

Only 22 new additional drops needed.

Question #4:

All drops for ceiling mounted WAPs or do they need to go down walls?

Response:

All are ceiling mounted.

Question #5:

Any physical "firewalls" that would impede straight runs in-ceiling?

Response:

There are no immediate obstructions in the way for these drops.

Question #6:

Do you need Switches installed? Patched?

Response:

No

Ouestion #7: Do you need patch panels?

• Do you have space in existing patch panels?

• How many IDF closets per location? 1 to 2

Question #9:

Cable type: Cat 6? Plenum?

Response:

Cat 6 plenum rated solid core.

Question #10:

After-hours work?

Response:

This shouldn't be necessary. WAPs and UPSs can be deployed during business hours.

Ouestion #11:

UPS-Are we installing new or replacing existing? Who is responsible to shut down & restart equipment?

Response:

Most cases will be a direct replacement. County IT will assist with restart of equipment.

Question #12:

UPS's delivered to each site or will we need to transport? What needs to happen with the old UPS's (us to recycle or leave with the site?)

Response:

Delivered and installed per site. If a central staging area is needed, they can be delivered to one site, 722 Moody Galveston Texas.

Question #13:

22 new cables installed – assuming there is room on existing patch panels. Do the techs need to do any testing of AP's after installation? If so, what testing will need to be done?

Response:

No testing of APs.

Question #14:

Network Equipment:

Does the County prefer Cisco DNA Essential or DNA Advantage for the APs and Switches in the RFP? Will all APs and Switches require this licensing?

Response:

DNA Advantage on all switches and APs

UPS Equipment Ouestion #15:

- Per SOW requesting- (9) Eaton UPS 650. Eaton doesn't make a 650 UPS, Tripp-Lite does. Can we substitute with a 700VA? 700VA is fine
- Per SOW requesting- (9) Eaton UPS 750. Same, Eaton offers a 700VA, we can go with next size up- 1000VA or step down- 700VA. Which would be preferred? They make a 750VA rack mounted ups model 5P750R
- Per SOW requesting- (42) Eaton UPS 2200. The 2200VA has a 208V plug, if 120V is in place? Eaton can offers 2000VA. Which would be preferred? Spec the 2200va that uses 120v 20 Amp input model 5PX2200RT
- Does the county have a centralized warehouse to ship and store all equipment? 722 Moody Galveston Texas, 2nd floor.

Ouestion #16:

Data Drops

- Please provide specs and floor plans There are no floor plans available for these locations, all are low ceiling. Response must assume less than 150 ft run for a flat rate per drop.
- Per Scope- Cable drops not to exceed 150ft. What if a cable run is longer than 150ft, is a change order acceptable? For these cases we can either go with a change order or cancel the drop.
- Is work to be performed during regular business hours or After Hours labor is required? Regular business hours should be fine.
