 - _____ Level Two – (Rule 190.3) Discovery shall be completed the earlier of 30 days before the date set for trial or 9 months after the date of the first oral deposition or the due date of the first response to written discovery.
 - _____ Level Three – (Rule 190.4) Discovery shall be completed by this date.
- 4. _____ MEDIATION shall be completed by this date.
- 5. _____ AMENDED PLEADINGS deadline.
- 6. Due one week prior to trial JOINT PRE-TRIAL ORDER shall be filed by this date in the form enclosed with the notice of this Order, except by written agreement of all parties.
- 7. _____ PRETRIAL CONFERENCE will be held. Trial counsel are ordered to attend and be prepared to discuss all aspects of the suit and trial.
