State law requires your divorce be on file for a minimum of 60 days before it can be finalized. Your divorce is NOT automatically granted upon the expiration of sixty (60) days. No divorce will be granted without a *Waiver of Service* or *Return of Citation* on file with the court.

In order to complete your uncontested family case, you <u>must</u> have your paperwork reviewed by the Friend of the Courts.

In an effort to protect ourselves and each other, there will be **NO PERSONAL CONTACT** with the Friend of the Courts during this time.

PRO SE PARTIES MAY SUBMIT THEIR COMPLETED PAPERWORK TO THE OFFICE OF THE FRIEND OF THE COURTS BY PLACING IT IN THE LARGE ENVELOPE PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE AND TURNING THE ENVELOPE IN VIA THE DISTRICT CLERK'S MAILBOX, LOCATED IN FRONT OF THE COURTHOUSE AT 600 59<sup>TH</sup> ST., GALVESTON, TEXAS, AT THE FRONT OF THE CIRCULAR DRIVE.

Once you have submitted your paperwork, the Friend of the Courts will contact you with any questions, comments or updates regarding your case.
