2. \_\_\_\_\_ **EXPERTS** for all parties shall be designated by this date. Experts for all other parties shall be designated 30 days after this date. No additional experts will be permitted to testify, except for good cause.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ **INVENTORIES AND APPRAISEMENT MUST BE ON FILE BY THIS DATE.**
4. \_\_\_\_\_ **DISCOVERY** shall be completed by this date. Counsel may, by agreement, continue discovery beyond this deadline, such continued discovery, however, will not delay the trial date.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ **MEDIATION** will be completed by this date. **Mediation may be waived by the Court if there is no dispute as to property.** If parties cannot agree on a mediator, you must contact the Court, in writing, within fifteen (15) days so that one may be appointed for you.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ **AMENDMENTS** to pleadings shall be filed by this date.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ **JURY CHARGE** – counsel for all parties must submit jury questions, definitions and instructions with a copy mailed to the Court.
8. \_\_\_\_\_ **PRE-TRIAL CONFERENCE** will be held at 10:30 a.m. Trial counsel are ordered to attend and be prepared to discuss all aspects of the suit and trial.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ **PROPOSED DIVISION OF PROPERTY** shall be filed and exchanged by this date. (In property cases)
