TO THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF FRIENDSWOOD:

The City of Friendswood has contracted with Galveston County for election services related to its Special Elections to be held on May 4, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting for or against Proposition A related to the reauthorization of the City's street maintenance local sales and use tax for another four years. The ballot language will be set forth substantially in the form listed below:

Voters will be able to see the information but will not be able to vote as the individuals have already been declared elected. Early Voting by Personal Appearance will begin on Monday, April 22, 2024, and end on Tuesday, April 30, 2024. The Galveston County Elections Division will administer the City of Friendswood's May 4, 2024, elections. As such, Friendswood voters from both Harris County and Galveston County will have the same voting by personal appearance and schedule. Below is the early voting by personal appearance information:

Ballots by mail applications can be requested at any time; however, the last day to apply for a ballot by mail is at the close of business on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 (received, not postmarked). Federal Post Card Applications (FPCAs) must also be received no later than the close of business on Tuesday, April 23, 2024. Residents applying for a ballot by mail shall send their application to the Early Voting Clerk of the county in which they are registered to vote. However, note that for this election Harris County Voters will receive their election ballot and ballot material from the Galveston County Elections Divisions. Harris County voters should follow the instructions provided in the election materials for the return of the marked ballot. Below is the information for each county to request a mail ballot:

**** If an application is sent to the early voting clerk by fax or email, the original application must still be mailed, and received by the early voting clerk no later than the 4th business day after receiving the emailed or faxed ABBM or faxed FPCA, to the address shown above for Regular Mail.

Hart InterCivic Verity equipment shall be used for early voting by personal appearance and at the designated Election Day countywide polling locations listed below. Electronic counting devices and equipment shall be used for counting the ballots.

Election Day is Saturday, May 4, 2024, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and the countywide polling locations identified below will serve Friendswood voters from both Harris County and Galveston County. Please note that the Countywide Polling Locations are subject to change up to Election Day and Friendswood voters may choose to vote at any designated voting center.
