INSPECTION

INSPECTION

- A. Developer or his/her engineer will notify the County Engineer's Office and the applicable Galveston County Drainage District by letter seven (7) days prior to when construction of improvements is to begin. Contractor shall provide a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours advance notice to County Engineer, of each day's construction. Failure to do so may result in rejection, by County, for acceptance and maintenance. Inspections shall be scheduled on normal County working days Monday through Friday.
1. To insure conformance with the final subdivision plat and drawings as approved by the Commissioners' Court, a representative of the County Engineer will inspect the subdivision during construction and after construction is completed. The applicable Galveston County Drainage District may monitor construction related to their jurisdiction.
 2. The Inspectors, under the direct supervision of the applicable Galveston County Drainage District and the County Engineer will report their findings and note variations from the approved drawings. If the developer fails to correct these variations, the subdivision may not be accepted by the Commissioners' Court or the Drainage District.
- B. Inspection costs will be paid by the Developer to the County before the subdivision plat is approved by the Commissioners' Court and recorded in the County Clerk's office. These costs will be determined on a case by case basis by the County.
