UA's

National Screening Centers will remain open for business until further notice. Continue Urinalysis Protocol as directed. If your color is called, you shall report to the nearest National Screening Center location. Failure to comply will result in non-compliance and VTC sanction.

Report In's

To facilitate social distancing, you will be notified of contact visits by Johnathan Bouvier. Phone report-ins will be authorized on case-by-case basis only. Failure to comply will result in non-compliance and VTC sanction.

VA Treatment

If you have a "**scheduled**" VA treatment appointment, you shall continue your treatment as directed. If VA changes, cancels, or reschedules your appointment, provide Mr. Bouvier with these updates. If you are feeling sick, you must contact VA to reschedule appointments, then provide Mr. Bouvier with these updates.

We note this is an evolving situation. For Veterans, families and visitors, that means your VA visit will be different for a while. As a community, VA's goal is to contain or prevent spread of COVID-19. Only Veterans, limited (approved) visitors, and those with official business are allowed access to VA buildings.
