The following information is being provided to aid in preparation of your bid submittal(s):

Question #1: What is the definition of a local government officer as it relates to the CIQ form?

As referenced in Local Government Code, Section 176.001; Definitions: Response:

> "Local government officer" means: (4)

a member of the governing body of a local governmental entity;

a director, superintendent, administrator, president, or other person designated as the executive officer of a local governmental entity; or

(C) an agent of a local governmental entity who exercises discretion in the planning, recommending, selecting, or contracting of a vendor.

I saw where no vending machines are allowed. Does this include a public ice Question #2: machine?

Response: This requirement <u>does not</u> include public ice machines. Ice machines are allowed.

Is there a minimum on the bid? Question #3:

Response: Currently written, the minimum bid is \$1,000.00/month. Question #4: ...i cannot get a inspector in until next week there all backed up for two weeks...

Response:

There is no requirement of the proposal submittal to have the building inspected. The County cannot guarantee the state of the structure. Inspections come at the expense of the proposer. The building and grounds come as is.
