To All Prospective Proposers:

The following information is being provided to aid in preparation of your bid submittal(s):

**Question #1:** *Request for Proposals, General Provisions Section, Page 1, Paragraph 1 Proposal Package (8<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) states "Proposals must be submitted in sets of two (2), one (1) unbound original and one (1) copy." Please confirm that bidders may submit the original and copy in separate three-ring binders.*

Response: Yes.

**Question #2:** *Request for Proposals, General Provisions Section, Page 3, Paragraph 5 Proposal Opening (10<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) states "The Purchasing Agent shall open the proposals on the date and time specified herein. Only the name of the proposers will be read at the opening." Will bidder representatives be permitted to attend the opening? If not, can the identity of bidders be obtained in some other manner (e-mail notification, etc.)?*

Response: Yes, representatives may attend the bid openings, however, masks and social distancing mandates are realized in county buildings. Whatever is read out at the bid openings is public knowledge and can be obtained from the Purchasing Department upon request.

**Question #3:** *Request for Proposals, General Provisions Section, Page 4, Paragraph 9 Restrictive or Ambiguous Specifications (11<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) states "Any protest or question(s) regarding the specifications or proposal procedures must be received in the Purchasing Agent's Office not less than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the time set for proposal opening." Seventy-two (72) hours leaves very little time for the County to post responses to provider questions and for bidders to adjust their offers accordingly. For those providers who will make a bid/no bid determination based solely upon the County's responses to bidder questions, please consider extending the proposal due date to fourteen (14) days beyond the date that the responses are posted.*

Response: All addenda responding to any questions received are posted at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. If any question(s) received less than seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date are dire enough to materially change the bid responses, a notice of an extension of the opening date will be issued to address the issue.

**Question #4:** *Request for Proposals, General Provisions Section, Page 6, Paragraph 16 Pre-Proposal Conference (13<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document): Please advise of the date, time, location, and/or alternate means of participating in the pre-proposal conference, if scheduled.*

Response: There is no pre-proposal conference scheduled for this solicitation.

**Question #5:** *Request for Proposals, General Provisions Section, Page 14, Paragraph 38 Proposal Guarantee and Paragraph 39 Performance and Payment Bonds (if required) (21<sup>st</sup> page of the entire document): Please confirm that bidders will not be required to submit a financial guarantee or performance and payment bond with their proposals or before beginning work.*

Response: No bonds are required for this solicitation.

**Question #6:** *Request for Proposals, Page 2, Qualifications to Bid (43<sup>rd</sup> page of the entire document) states "Proposer must be able to serve CSCD at any location or satellite offices within the jurisdiction as required by CSCD." Would the County consider awarding a contract to a Proposer that provides services exclusively by electronic means (without in-person contact or an office in Galveston County) using an online/video program delivery model that has proven experience and positive references with other CSCDs operating within the State of Texas?*

Response: Yes.

**Question #7:** *Request for Proposals, Page 4, Overview (45<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) and Page 5 Contract Period (46<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) states "Providers will submit monthly invoices for payment for services to the CSCD. Any other funds (including client participant fees) available to the proposer from public or private sources shall be deducted from the total billable amount to the CSCD if proposer is offered a contract. Services provided will be paid for from the appropriate fiscal year funds provided by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice-Community Justice Assistance Division (TDCJ-CJAD)." Please confirm that the County will subsidize the full cost of all approved services provided under the resulting contract.*

Response: If client is able to provide any form of payment for services, this amount shall be deducted from the billable amount to the CSCD.

**Question #8:** *Request for Proposals, Page 19 Proposal Submission Requirements, General on Paragraph 2 (60<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document) states "Each proposal must respond to all portions of the RFP." Two different segments of the document encompassing 86 pages – not counting each of the required forms – are titled "Request for Proposal." Would providers bidding only for operation of the outpatient program meet the County's expectations by responding only to the instructions outlined in:*

- A. *Request for Proposals, Page 20 Proposal Format Requirements (61<sup>st</sup> page of the entire document);*
- B. *Request for Proposals, Page 21 Required Information (62<sup>nd</sup> page of the entire document);*
- C. *Request for Proposals, Page 24 Specific Requirements for Non-Residential Counseling/Treatment Services (65<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document);*
- D. *Request for Proposals, Page 25 Program Performance Measures (66<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document); and*
- E. *Request for Proposals, Page 25 Agency Evaluation Methods (66<sup>th</sup> page of the entire document).*

Response: Providers shall respond to the sections of the proposal that relate to the types of services able to be provided.

**Question #9:** *Please clarify whether it is the County's intent to award contracts to a single provider or multiple providers. If multiple providers may be selected, will the County consider proposals from companies that offer outpatient services-only?*

Response: Multiple providers will be considered based on the needs of the CSCD. The CSCD will consider proposals from companies that offer outpatient services only.

**Question #10:** *Will the County require a specific curriculum for provider(s) to follow in the delivery of services? If so, please identify the name of the curriculum or sample curriculum to be used.*

Response: Providers shall appropriate chemical dependency treatment as designated by a documented Axis 1 substance abuse or substance dependency diagnosis recommending the specific treatment being provided by the Vendor.

**Question #11:** *Please identify the number of offenders that the provider may anticipate serving per month or per year.*

Response: This number will vary based on the needs of defendants and the CSCD.

**Question #12:** *Please identify the names(s) of the incumbent treatment provider(s), if any.*

**Question #13:** *If one or more providers currently deliver the services solicited in this RFP, please identify all rates charged in their pricing structure.*

**Question #14:** *Bidders typically convert RFP documents from PDF to Word, then build their proposals around the specifications copied from the resulting report. The poor quality of this particular document renders that strategy useless, forcing bidders to spend crucial time retyping the entire manuscript – time that could be employed in the development of a solution that would be most beneficial to the County – as well as creating the potential for typographical errors that could change the meaning or requirements of a specification(s). Could the County provide a Word version of the RFP or a clearer copy in PDF?*

Response: No Word version of the document will be provided as the possibility of changing the document by the proposer is at risk.
