The following information is being provided to aid in preparation of your proposal submittal(s):

Question #1: The RFP references that economic studies are part of this initiative: Will these economic studies

the website or is the expectation that the firm should provide economic study services?

Response: Please see the listing into Item 2 of Appendix A. That listing is an example of the types of data sources

that are common to economic development websites. The proposer must demonstrate integration of US Census data, commercial real estate listings, state workforce data, GIS maps and data and other similar

sources common to these types of websites.

The vendor will be expected to demonstrate experience in the integration of these types of data sources.
