Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Rate

The Galveston County Fresh Water Supply District #6 will hold a public hearing on a proposed tax rate for the tax year 2021 on September 15, 2021 at 5:00 pm at Public Safety Building, 747 Tiki Drive, Tiki Island, Texas. Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the tax rate that is adopted and on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property. The change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in the taxable value of all other property determines the distribution of the tax burden among all property owners.
