The County's ARPA program, still in a very early stage, with some areas in final development are outlined below in a high-level draft, including a general distribution plan:

Funding Distribution:

- Public Health/Covid Response \$16,000.000.00
- Public Safety\$4,000,000.00
- Building and Facility Projects \$15,000,000.00
- Sewer & Storm Water Infrastructure Improvements \$25,500,000.00
- Parks Projects\$500,000.00
- Essential Worker Pay \$3,453,100.00
- Economic Development/Non Profit Programs \$2,000,000.00

In conjunction with ARPA, the County has launched an \$8M ERA2 program, utilizing a community non-profit to further enhance and complement our ARPA programs.
